## Mathematics

The children will continue to work on *Measurement*, learning to:

- measure and record time;
- order the days of the week;
- solve practical problems involving time;
- recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

## Other Curriculum Subjects

In science, the children will be learning about everyday materials, to identify, name and describe a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, water and rock.

In humanities, the children be looking at significant historical events, people and places in their own locality, focusing on London at WW2.

In art therapy, the children will be making art of WW2, and preparing and cooking food from WW2.

In computing, the children will produce short videos of themselves making a healthy meal or snack.

Every week the children will receive homework in a purple homework folder with a spelling exercise and a piece of maths, which may be a simple practical activity at home.
