Mathematics

The children will continue to work on *Properties of Shape and Position and Direction*, learning to:

- Name and recognise common 2D and 3D shapes;
- Use language of direction and position;
- Describe direction of turn using clockwise and anticlockwise.

Other Curriculum Subjects

In science, the children will be learning about electricity , to identify common appliances that run on electricity, and to construct a simple series electrical circuit. They will also discuss safety rules which relate to the dangers of using mains electricity.

In humanities, the children be looking at the four countries and the capitals of the UK, to become familiar with maps of the United Kingdom and to identify England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

In art therapy, the children will be making a torch and creating different textures.

In computing, the children will create pictures and patterns from regular shapes, using the Interactive White Board.

Every week the children will receive homework in a purple homework folder with a spelling exercise and a piece of maths, which may be a simple practical activity at home.
