Mathematics

In Mathematics we will covering the following topics.

- Number and place value
- Addition & subtraction - decimals
- Shape, measure and data
- Multiplication and division - decimals
- Fractions, division & data
- Algebra
- Problem solving

It would be helpful if you could encourage your child to revisit what they covered during their daily maths lesson and to practise their times tables weekly.

Other Curriculum Subjects

Science: This half term we will continue to be covering materials and their properties— carrying out experiments to find out how substances dissolve and separate, as well as looking at reversible changes of materials.

Humanities: This half term we will be looking at the Water Cycle and Coastlines—how they are formed by erosion and the impact humans have on them.

R.E: This half term we will be using research skills to plan questions and find out key information about famous people and the impact their faith has had on their lives.

PE: This term we will be having PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit in school.

Art: We will be linking our Art to Geography this term by drawing, then making an island which shows different types of coastal erosion.

PSHE: In PSHE this half term, we will be talking about dilemmas which the children could encounter in their lives.

Music: During our music lessons, we will be studying Benjamin Britten and learning some of the songs he wrote for children.

Homework: The children are set one piece of English or Maths every week. They are also given spellings to learn and are expected to read a minimum of 3 times a week. Homework is set on a Wednesday and handed in on the following Monday.
