Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will be focusing on the following objectives:

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables
- Identify horizontal and vertical lines and pairs of perpendicular and parallel lines.
- Measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes .
- Add and subtract numbers mentally
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.
- Count up and down in tenths; recognise that tenths arise from dividing an object into 10 equal parts and in dividing one -digit numbers or quantities by 10.

Other Curriculum Subjects

History— During this term we will be finding out all about The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. The children will be learning where this appears chronologically in a timeline and will be finding out about life in the Roman times, Boudicca, Roman food, pottery, clothing and housing and how these have influenced Britain today.

Science—During this half term we will be investigating Forces and Magnets. The children will be learning about forces in general and magnetic forces specifically. We will look at how they have two poles and can attract and repel and identify magnetic materials. They will be predicting, carrying out investigations and planning a fair test to assist with their learning in this topic.

R.E.—During this half term the children will be learning about 'Islam: Beliefs and teachings'. The children will learn about Allah and his message through the Qur'an as well as stories of Muhammad.

P.S.H.E.—During this half term our topic will be 'Relationships'. The children be identifying people who are important to them, how they can express feelings of guilt and what guilt means. We will also discuss taking responsibility for our actions and how to express ourselves when we are feeling hurt or angry.

French—Bi-Weekly with the French teacher from RPHS

Computing—This half term we shall be focussing on programming. We will use logo and scratch to create and debug algorithms.

P.E.—During this half term we will be continuing Taekwondo and practicing games skills with Coach Ryan outside. This will still be on Friday afternoons.
